ORDINANCE #521

“WATER RATES”

The City of Claremont Ordains:

Pursuant to New Hampshire RSA 47:17 and Section 20-166 of the Claremont City Code, Article IV of Chapter 20, Utilities, the Schedule for Water Rates, as adopted by Ordinance #505, shall be amended as follows.

Section 1 Fire Protection Charges

Scheduled charges related to water connections for fire prevention purposes shall be revised as follows:

Sec. 2 Fire Protection Charges

In addition to charges based on volume and meter size, each user of water supplied by the City who has a water connection for fire prevention purposes, including both hydrants and fire suppression systems, shall pay, semiannually, an additional charge as follows:

Sec. 3 Public Hydrants

The Fire Department shall pay an additional annual charge as follows, which may be billed semi-annually.

Section 2 Additional Provisions

All other provisions related to billing and payment for all charges for use of City water, as set forth in Ordinance #406, adopted by the City Council on September 13, 2000, and Ordinance #505, adopted by the City Council on March 10, 2010 remain in effect and are unchanged.

Section 3 Enforcement

This Ordinance shall be enforced by the Department of Public Works' Water Division.

Section 4 Validity

If any article, section, subsection, sentence, clause or phrase of this ordinance is for any reason held to be unconstitutional or invalid, such decision shall not affect the remaining portions of this ordinance.

Section 5 Effective Date

This Ordinance and the changes to the Fire Protections Charges contained herein shall take effect and be enforced immediately upon adoption.
