Participants will pay a nominal \$8 fee (\$10 non-resident) to ride the Parks and Recreation Bus and will have the luxury of sitting back and relaxing or talking with friends while we take care of the driving.

The first trip will be to Lincoln, NH to ride the Hobo Railroad on Tuesday, September 27th. Participants will be able to view the colorful Fall Foliage along the Pemigewassett River. Pack a lunch or purchase the famous Hobo Picnic Lunch while enjoying your train ride.

Our next adventure takes you to wonderful Billings Farm to celebrate the Vermont harvest on Saturday, October 8th. Activities at Billings Farm include a traditional husking bee and barn dance, cider pressing, harvesting of root vegetables and many more!

Our final trip of 2011 takes participants to the always exciting Yankee Candle in Massachusetts on Thursday, December 8th. After Yankee Candle, eat a late lunch at HomeTown Buffet and then enjoy a winter wonderland ride through the splendid Bright Nights at Forest Park. Bright Nights boasts more than 600,000 lights along a 3-mile route.
