Bill Carpenter opened the meeting at 12:20 p.m. Surveyor Tom Dombrowski described two options for the sculpture location (attached). Ernest Montenegro, the designer of the sculpture described the vision and aesthetics for Option 1. The committee and city staff discussed both options. Fire Chief Rick Bergeron stated that the base of the structure was one point of measurement, but the sculpture is not straight up and down, but curves with the southern tip extending off of the base. In order to have clear feet for fire apparatus the southern-most tip of the structure would have to be 16' or it will have to be moved back further on the pad.

A proposal was made to move the center of the sculpture as located in Option 1, 8'6" north to meet the setbacks and clearance for emergency apparatus.

Motion by Nick Koloski, seconded by David Lucier, to table the discussion until full structural drawings showing setbacks and clearance are available to the committee.

Meeting ended at 1:45 p.m.
