Minutes for the Airport Advisory Meeting of April 29, 2013

The meeting was called to order at 7:00 p.m. at the Claremont Municipal Airport by Chief Rick Bergeron. Also present were board members Joe Osgood, Dave Eno, David Carton and Roger Hamel.

The minutes from the January 28, 2013 meeting were reviewed by the board members present and accepted as read.

The board discussed the possibility of having a non-resident serve on the board. Mr. Osgood advised the board that he was aware of a recent incident where it was reiterated that non Claremont residents may not serve on any local boards. The manager will follow up with the city legal department to get accurate info.

The manager and board discussed the widely fluctuating aviation gasoline market. Mr. Hamel advised the board that CNH was one dollar lower in price per gallon when compared with Nashua Airport. The manager commented that the price may easily change by as much as \$.15/gallon each week.....some weeks up and others down.....it is simply a matter of timing.

The board entered into a discussion about the problems that the airport experienced in February and March with the runway lights. Mr. Hamel stated that the electricians had dug up one of the lights and found a damaged wire, but it could not be stated that this was in fact the cause of the larger issue. They will return to replace the non working light at a later date. The manager advised the board that this minor repair cost over two thousand dollars as these specialized service people had to travel from Maine and that he had examined other options with uncertain results.

The manager advised the board that he was hoping to undertake at least one more brush clearing project along the fence line sometime this year and would also perform some work on the Twistback Hill beacon.

Questions and comments were entertained, and the meeting was adjourned at 7:32 p.m.
