FALL CLEAN-UP

The Fall Clean-up Program in the City of Claremont will operate for one week beginning **Monday, October 31, 2016 through Friday, November 4, 2016.**

Leaves and grass rakings must be placed in **COMPOSTABLE PAPER BAGS AND LEFT AT THE CURBSIDE BY 7:00 AM ON MONDAY, October 31, 2016.** **THERE WILL BE NO CALL BACKS.** Leaves in plastic bags will not be picked up; nor will garbage, brush or household items be collected.

After November 4th, Claremont citizens may bring leaves, bagged in compostable biodegradable bags, to the Transfer Station on Tuesdays & Saturdays at no cost.

Per City Council policy adopted on May 12, 2004, the Public Works Department will no longer accept or pick up leaves that are not in paper, biodegradable bags. Paper Compostable (30) gallon bags are available at various local hardware, grocery, and department stores.
