


## CLAREMONT TRANSFER STATION DECALS AND PROCESS



(decals are 3 inches wide and 2 ¾ inches high)

### FOR CLAREMONT HOUSEHOLD TRASH ONLY

- Decals to be issued by Central Collections
- Vehicle must be registered in Claremont
- Vehicle plate number is written on the Decal (**red**) using permanent black marker
- Decal to be placed on lower left corner of rear window (driver's side)
- If driving a company issued vehicle, give a Temporary Decal (**blue**)
  - Write plate number and expiration date of the registration on the decal using permanent black marker
  - Needs to be renewed every year.
  - Have driver sign a form saying that they will only use the Transfer Station for Claremont household trash
- Non-resident property owner, give a Temporary Decal (**blue**)
  - Write plate number and expiration date of the registration on the decal using permanent black marker
  - Needs to be renewed every year.
  - Have driver sign a form saying that they will only use the Transfer Station for Claremont household trash
- If just moved into Claremont, issue Special Permit (paper) until they register their vehicle
  - This is specific to the address of the individual and usually lasts for a 60-day period
  - They must prove Claremont residency
