

Ad Hoc Committee – Transfer Station

Meeting called to order at 05:12pm by Charlene Lovett.

Members present: Charlene Lovett, Bob Picard and Joe Osgood

Bob arrived at 5:29.

Charlene moved, Joe seconded to accept 02/09/2015 minutes with changes. Pass

Discussion on decal fees and reasons to have them was held. It was agreed that there should be no more than two decals per household. At least one should be \$5.00 and the other free if two are requested. Some suggested the first one should be free and the second one \$5.00 while others preferred the other way around.

Discussion on Committee recommendation to Council. Recommendation should include that decals be required to use the transfer station, a maximum of two per household be issued, and that a fee of no more than \$5.00 for either the first or the second decal be charged. Recommendation to be decided upon by the Council.

The use of decals is to establish data for the Ad Hoc Committee – Transfer Station for cost analysis and future recommendations.

Bob moved, Joe seconded that this be brought to Council on 2/25/2015. Pass

Discussion with input from the public as how to encourage recycling in such a small community and make it cost effective. It was clear that the public present would like to see some form of recycling. Some discussion about the private transfer station in Newport and how it operates came up.
