

Ad Hoc Committee – Transfer Station
April 16, 2015

Meeting called to order at 5:02 pm by Charlene Lovett

Members present: Charlene Lovett and Joe Osgood
absent: Bob Picard.

Charlene stated she would like to have us attend a Sullivan County town transfer station that is doing a good job of recycling and suggested Unity. If this Saturday (April 18th) is OK, only one member can legally attend because there is not enough time to warn the trip as a meeting. It was agreed that Charlene would attend. The next visit should be to a community of like size within the State that is doing well with the return on the dollar. Although Keene is a larger community, there are reports they are doing well and would be a good place to pick up information. These will be decided at the next meeting.

Motion made by Joe, seconded by Charlene to have the Transfer Station Ad Hoc Committee recommend to the Council that they require the City Manager and a representative from DPW attend Transfer Station Ad Hoc Committee meetings until finances pertaining to the Transfer Station are clearly defined for all concerned parties, and to have a DPW representative available to the Transfer Station Ad Hoc Committee to provide information as needed. Motion Passed.

Charlene will see if the Mayor will allow the Committee to make this motion at the next Council meeting.

Charlene reported that she has not heard from the manager as to who should or could go the Transfer Station on a Saturday to spot weigh bags. Joe stated it is not practical to have paid employees doing this when committee members are willing to do it. Charlene agreed.

Input from the public indicated that they feel the City Manager is not being very helpful in this process.
