

Streets & Roads Department Interesting Facts

The City of Claremont is 43.1 square miles and resident population is 13,000+ consisting of over 4,400 residential homes and over 700 business properties.

Within the City limits, the Department of Public Works, Streets and Roads Department maintains:

- 126 miles of roads or 252 lane miles of which 20 miles are gravel.
- The City also has several Private, Class VI and State of NH roads which are not maintained by City staff
- Approximately 35 miles of sidewalks.
- Over 2000 signs.

Operate and maintain a fleet of equipment, for the Streets and Roads Department, Cemetery, Sanitation Recycling and Utilities Department which includes:

- 35 trucks, ranging from a half-ton pickup to 6-Wheel dump trucks
- 4 backhoes
- 3 loaders
- 1 grader
- 1 street sweeper
- 3 tractors
- 2 Bobcats'
- 1 chipper and 1 hay mulcher
- 2 rollers, 1 reclaimer and 2 cement mixers
- 1 culvert steamer
- 2 sidewalk plows; numerous plows, wings, sanders, and snow blowers
- 2 jetters and a rodder
- 1 valve exercise machine
- 7 trailers
- 3 forklifts
- numerous mowers, chain saws, hand equipment, tools

Maintain an additional 30 +/- vehicles and equipment for the Claremont Fire Department and the Parks and Recreation Department.

Oversee line painting for the City, including:

- (191) stop bars; (119) line arrows; (140) crosswalks; (10) handicap decals; (550) parking stalls; (9) railroad crossings; (225,000 lf) of yellow center lines; (3,146 lf) of yellow gore lines; (98,200 lf) of edge lines; (16) school zone lines.

Maintain 12 bridges.

Maintain 40 downtown street lights, (the City has 1018 LED street lights.)
