CONSTRUCTION UPDATE

Construction update for 6/3/22 through 6/10/22

The City of Claremont's contractor, B.U.R Construction, will continue sidewalk construction on Pleasant Street. The Westside pedestrian sidewalk is almost complete, less the North and South end tie-in to existing sidewalks. The Eastside sidewalk is fine graded and concrete placement for the pedestrian walkway is scheduled to begin next week. Construction of the Westside furniture zone planter areas will continue.

On Broad Street, sidewalk construction is complete less the area from Barber Street to the Fire Station, which is scheduled to begin with the removal of the existing sidewalk and placement of new curb.

There may be impacts to through traffic and the number of parking spaces available during working hours within the work zone on Pleasant Street. Utilizing the City of Claremont's public parking lots is encouraged.

With the continued construction on Broad Street, traffic through the area will be affected due to lane closures within the work area and slight delays should be expected.
