RE: City of Claremont Water Main Shut Down

As part of the Pleasant Street Revitalization Project the City of Claremont's contractor, B.U.R. Construction will be replacing a water main valve cluster at the intersection of Pleasant Street and Glidden Street. This work is vital to the functioning of the City's water system and will be replacing existing water main valves that have lasted past their original design lifecycle. To accomplish the work the water main is required to shut down on Pleasant Street from Myrtle Street to School Street as well as all of Glidden Street. The following residences and business will be affected:
